



Dear all,

The Charity Foundation of Małgosia Braunek "Bądź" alongside the Blyzkist collective and the support of many friends, has been actively raising funds to purchase medical supplies for hospitals in Ukraine since the start of the war. We act in partnership with volunteers of the Armed Forces and Territorial Defense of Ukraine who, on behalf of specific hospitals, update the lists of medicines and medical equipment necessary to save lives.

We are also in touch with non-governmental organizations supporting Ukraine, thanks to which necessary supplies go to the ones the most in need. So far, we have organized the great help for the military hospital in Chernivtsi and the Veterans Base Home hospital in Kyiv.

Unfortunately, the war in Ukraine is still going on. Both humanitarian aid and that directed to refugees (also those staying in Poland) are very much needed, and the Foundation's financial resources do not allow us to continue to help as much as we could afford in March, April, and May.

Donation levels in June to supply hospitals in Ukraine have dropped rapidly. We are able to send one more shipment from the funds we have left.

Nevertheless, we are still in touch with our friends in Ukraine, we know how much help is still needed. We are also active in Warsaw, developing a program dedicated to integration and assistance to those in need in Poland - Let's be close/Будьм близько. More on that below.

In total, from March this year to this day, we have managed to send aid to Ukraine worth:

- over PLN 600,000;
- PLN 430,000 of the whole amount was in a form of financial donations, thanks to which we were able to organize a total of 15 means of transport to Ukrainian hospitals, buy medical equipment, medicines and equipment for rapid surgery needed to save lives;

the rest came to us directly in the form of in-kind material donations.

But that's not all! Due to the great needs and enormous commitment of the Foundation's members and friends from Poland and abroad, we have also co-organized:

- transport of 4 trucks with medical and other equipment, distributed from Modlin;
- assistance in the transport of medications and food for diabetics;
- special assistance for injured soldiers in immediate danger of life, the drugs we provided were life-saving;
- support in the transport of drugs and specialized funds from the United States, provided by Father Ron Schmidt through our Foundation.
 With the support of Michelle Noordhof and MEDAT, two pallets of medications and specialist supplies are on the way, worth a total of \$15,000 for Terebovlya Central District Hospital;
- we are currently assisting in the purchase of materials and raw materials for the production of life-saving equipment, which will be produced in Ukraine

In March and April, we also organized two large fundraising meetings, prioritizing the needs of mainly women and children from Ukraine, currently staying in Poland. During the April meeting, we have already prepared and presented a project draft of long-term supporting and integrating activities for refugees and women refugees, which was greatly appreciated.

Currently, we are working with great commitment and hope to obtain funds to support our activities in Ukraine. We want the Foundation's statutory activities related to the improvement of health and education to be combined with activities for the integration and support of refugees in need.

We want to create a place in Warsaw where classes and meetings will support a sense of security and solidarity. That is why we are asking you for help! We launched our profile on Patronite, primarily with the intention of renting the space for our activities:

Thanks to your constant contributions, we will be able to meet freely in an open space, organize solidarity meetings, and support groups and integrate both at the level of activities dedicated to refugees and all those in need of support.

Enjoy the hospitality of "Otwarty Jazdów" from June to the end of August this year. Temporarily, we meet in the garden of the Rider's cottage on 10/2 with the program <u>Let's be close/Будьм близько</u>.

The Foundation co-creates this holiday project with the Blyzkist collective. As part of it, we offer:

- Free physical activity and art classes for children from 3 to 12 years old from Poland and Ukraine (with a Ukrainian language translator) held once a week;
- Free online psychological consultations in Ukrainian throughout the entire holiday period;
- Integrative, Sunday cycle cooking combined with learning about the culture of Ukraine - Cook, eat, explore! / Готуй, їж, знайо!
